For new students, a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit of the registration fee is required at the time of enrollment to hold each student's spot.

The registration fee is due by August 1, 2024.

If enrollment happens after the school year has begun then the Registration Fee will be due within two weeks of student's initial start date.

Once a student begins the school year, registration, building & maintenance, and parent volunteer fees are non-refundable.

Lunch Program

We offer nutritional and affordable lunches for all our students. Pre-payment is required.

- 6th through 12th Grades: \$3.75 a day, and milk alone is \$0.50

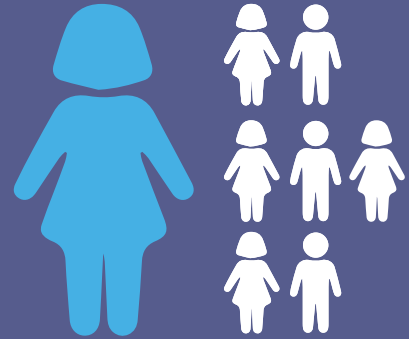
Enrichment Child Care

(Students must be 5 years old by September 1st to enroll in Kindergarten)

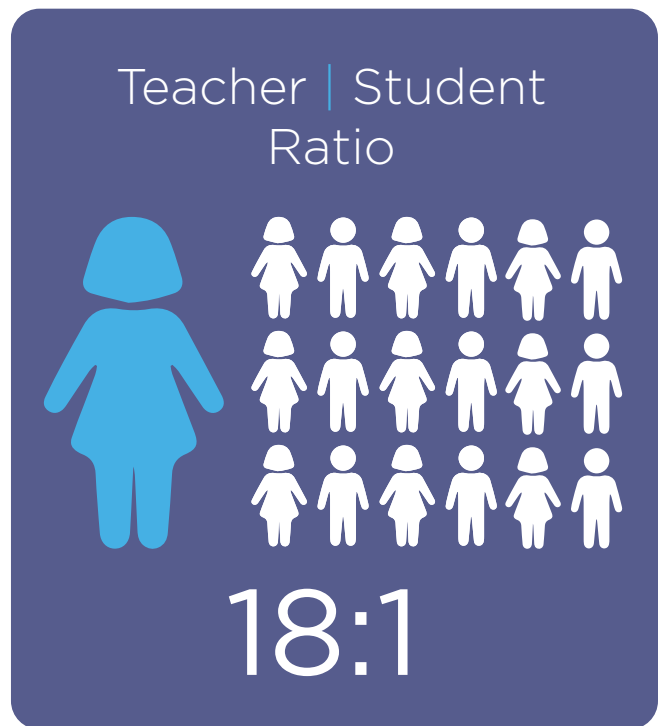
8:30 am to 3:00 pm Daily

* Bible - Bible credits are required for each trimester in attendance at Watersprings School.

**Two or more years of the same foreign language are strongly recommended and are required for admission to many colleges. Three years are required by some highly competitive colleges.

***PE - At Watersprings School, students who participate in sports are eligible to earn additional credits. These are reflected on a student's transcript as a participation credit in the appropriate sport. While a student can potentially earn many PE credits for PE classes taken and sports played, only 1 of the required 4 elective credits can be physical education related. The remaining 3 credits must be received for taking non-PE classes.

Credits - 1 credit is earned each trimester for each course successfully completed.





Athletics

Watersprings School has won both team state championships and individual state championships in addition to three academic state championships. We believe that participation in sports closely models life itself and provides an opportunity for kids to grow and mature into adulthood. Our student-athletes are taught teamwork, commitment, discipline, servant leadership, hard work, toughness, sportsmanship, perseverance, and sacrifice. We are members of the Idaho High School Activities Association and compete in IA Division II athletics.

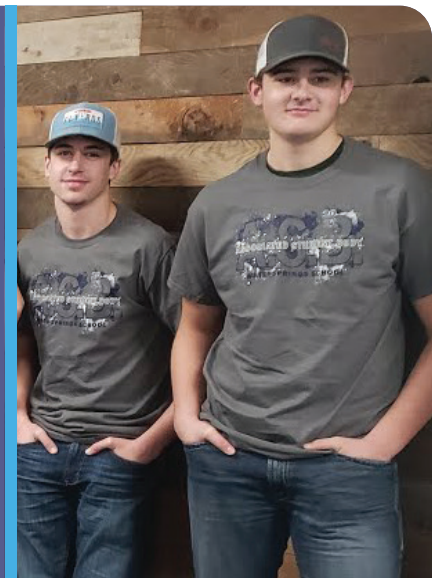
National Honor Society

VARIABLE TUITION

Making Christian Education Affordable

We understand that a Christian education is a huge investment for our families, so we offer an affordable option; Variable Tuition. Variable Tuition is a needs-based program, allowing families to apply for reduced tuition that fits their unique financial situation. Our goal is to make Watersprings School affordable and accessible to most families. Apply for Variable Tuition by going to online.factsmgmt.com/aid. (Not available for Preschool)

How does it work?

Any family may apply for Variable Tuition if they are concerned about affording the full tuition rate at Watersprings School. We use a 3rd party company to decide who qualifies and many factors are used to determine the tuition amount a family is able to pay such as income, assets, and the family size.

Do I need to apply to Watersprings School to receive Variable Tuition?

Yes. Admission acceptance will need to happen before applying for Variable Tuition.

Are all admitted students offered Variable Tuition if the family qualifies?

No. Unfortunately, the school does not have the ability to offer Variable Tuition to every student who qualifies for both admission and Variable Tuition. A student may be admitted to the school but placed on a waiting list for Variable Tuition. It is recommended that families apply for Variable Tuition as early as possible.

Do I need to apply for Variable Tuition every year?

Yes. A new application must be submitted every year.

If I do not qualify for the program this year, can I apply again next year?

Yes. A family that does not qualify is welcome to reapply the following year.

Should every family submit an application for Variable Tuition?

No. Only families who feel that they may not be able to pay the full tuition amount should submit a Variable Tuition application.

Do returning students receive priority over new students when applying for Variable Tuition?

Yes. Re-enrolling students who submit a re-enrollment application will receive priority consideration.

Will applying for Variable Tuition hurt my student's chance of being accepted to Watersprings School?

No. Both applications are evaluated separately, and applying for Variable Tuition has no bearing on the admissions process.

Do I need to apply for re-enrollment separately from applying for Variable Tuition?

Yes. For returning students the re-enrollment process must be completed before the application for Variable Tuition can be considered.

What kind of economic situation is typical of a family who qualifies for Variable Tuition?

Families with a wide variety of circumstances qualify for the program.

Are some families awarded full tuition?

No. Every family is required to make a financial investment in their child's education. Our commitment to providing Variable Tuition means that we are sharing in that investment with you.
